Heather Ann (Lesh) Forsha was a graduate of Unatego Central Schools, and received a Bachelor of Music and Masters of Music from Westminster Choir College, Princeton, NJ. She began her career in New Hampshire at the Concord Community Music School, where she taught piano and accompanied students and faculty for 15 years. During that time she also worked on the faculty of Summer Sonatina in Bennington, Vermont during her summers. She recently worked as an Adjunct Professor at Hartwick College, where she taught music theory, aural skills, class and individual piano. While there she accompanied numerous students, faculty and choirs. She was a church musician at the New Rye Congregational Church, New Rye, NH where she directed the adult and youth choirs, and was an accompanist for NYSSMA Area All State and Solo festivals. She was also a church musician at St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in Unadilla. A gifted musician, pianist, and accompanist, she offered her talents to other musicians in the schools and communities where she lived.
